It's that time of year again to register for Daytona's Ladies League. For those of you who have played with us before, you know Daytona's League is a no pressure league where we play on a well maintained, challenging course that is exciting for all levels of play. With that said, we do expect our league members to have a basic understanding of the game, some knowledge of golf etiquette and adhere to pace of play. Our league requires that each player play out/finish each hole even if they've exceeded their handicap on a hole. We don't expect new members to know all the rules, as there are many. No worries. We are happy to help with rules while we are in league play.

Daytona's Ladies League is an 18-hole league that meets every Saturday morning at 8:00 a.m. The beauty of our league is we have a guarantee tee time on a busy Saturday morning when most courses are typically full. If for some reason you can't make it to play that week you will not be charged. You only pay for the Saturdays you play. We only ask that you sign up to play by end of day Thursday for Saturday play. Knowing who and how many are playing will help us plan our weekly event and allow us to schedule the correct number of tee times needed for that Saturday. If there is a rain out you will be notified by text.

Regarding events, you will automatically be included in most events once you pay your dues of \$78. Our league hosts a different event each week of play with some events being team events and others individual. We have included the 2024 event sheet in this mailing. In addition to our weekly events, for those of you who like to make a little money on the side, simply sign up for "Skins" (Net/Gross). They are "optional" games and only cost \$3 total to participate in both (Net Game-your gross score minus handicap by hole-\$2/Gross score on one par 3 hole-\$1). These are fun games where everyone can win some money. You just need to sign up before we start playing.

In addition to the information about the dues, sign up form and event sheet that we have included, we have provided a flyer (jpeg) for you to post on your local "Nextdoor" site to try and draw in more league members. If you know other women who are interested in joining, please share this letter with them. Participating in a league helps you meet other women who have a love for the game and will help make you a better player.

Some of you have already been out golfing and enjoying the beautiful weather we have been having. It's hard to believe our spring weather started in February. Like so many other clubs in Minnesota, Daytona Golf Club has already opened for walking only (weather dependent). It's a great time to warm up for league play. Call the pro shop to make a tee time.

Breakdown of dues:

Individual handicap fee=\$33

You will need an 18 hole GHIN handicap <u>through Daytona</u> to play in the league. If you have an 18 hole GHIN number from a different course you still need pay for an 18 hole handicap through Daytona. If you were a member in 2023 you must pay your dues by May 10th or you will be removed from the GHIN system under Daytona.

Event Fund=\$45

The event fund goes to the weekly/season event payouts. All the prize money will be distributed at the fall banquet.
